

INCINERATOR

One major issue facing the residents of our Parish in 2008 is the possibility of a large incinerator being sited immediately to the South of Beaconsfield.

Buckinghamshire Waste Development Plan Document – Preferred Options Consultation Report (Regulation 26) was issued in June 2007 and a number of exhibitions staged in June and July 2007. Sufficient opposition was raised to the way in which this consultation was conducted that BCC were forced to reconsider the content and credibility of the document.

This is now due to be re-issued on 29 February 2008, following which an 8 week period will then be given to hold public consultations and receive comments.

It is believed that two of the sites being considered include Wapseys Wood, lying between Beaconsfield and Gerrards Cross, and Springfield Farm lying immediately South of Beaconsfield and the M40.

It is important that residents make themselves aware of this forthcoming consultation, and all it implies. They should be ready at this time to submit their own considered views to Buckinghamshire County Council.
